

Entry Requirements - A Reminder

Level 2 Certificate in Counselling Concepts

Open access is appropriate at this level but prospective candidates should be aware, either by interview or other suitable methods, that the course involves experiential learning and self-awareness exercises, which will be demanding of the self in interaction with others.

Whilst encouraging open access, centres do have an ethical responsibility to individual candidates, the student cohort, and ultimately to the community at large. Therefore, before admitting any person, centres should ensure, so far as they are able, that the person will be able to engage in the learning experience without harm to his/herself or others.

Prospective candidates should be made aware that this level of course is not intended to train counsellors and that they will not be qualified to practice as counsellors on completion of this course, or even claim to be competent in the use of counselling skills.
