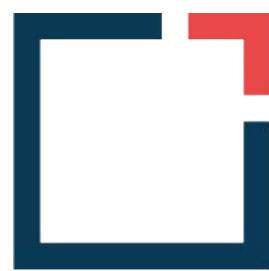

# LEVEL 5 BESPOKE TAILOR AND CUTTER

## Maximum funding:

£15,000 (Funding Band 11)

## End-point assessment fee:

£3,000 (excluding cancellations, re-sits and re-takes)

## Duration:

2 years

Apprentices will usually spend 18 months on-programme gaining skills, knowledge and developing behaviours in a bespoke tailoring organisation.

Confirmation that the apprentice has met the on-programme requirements can be supported through the achievement of the ABC Level 5 Diploma in Bespoke Tailoring (601/8252/0).

## Entry requirements:

Employers set their own entry requirements; however these may include that the apprentice is proficient in complex stitching and making processes.

## Gateway requirements:

Apprentices will need to achieve Level 2 in English and maths.

## The assessment:

The apprentice will be assessed against either the Tailor or Cutter requirements. The three components of the assessment are: assignment research project, the final project and a professional presentation and discussion.



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
