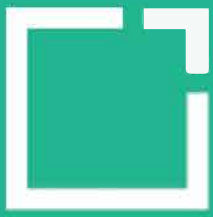

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Maximum funding:

£4,000

End-point assessment fee:

£800 (excluding cancellations, resits and retakes).

Duration: 1 year

Full time apprentices will typically spend between 12 months on-programme working towards the apprenticeship standard with a minimum of 20% off-the-job training. Once the apprentice has passed through Gateway they will have 8 weeks to complete their End-Point-Assessment.

Entry requirements:

Employers will set their own entry requirements for this standard.

END-POINT ASSESSMENT

LEVEL 2 TEXTILES MANUFACTURING OPERATIVE

Gateway requirements:

Apprentices will need to achieve level 1 English and Mathematics and must take the tests for Level 2 English and Mathematics prior to taking their End- Point Assessment. Apprentices will need to produce a portfolio of evidence that underpins the observation and Questioning.

The assessment:

The apprentice will be assessed against the Textiles Manufacturing Operative requirements. The two methods of assessments are:

- Knowledge test
- Observation and questioning, underpinned by a portfolio of evidence.

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
